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


1. GOOD PRACTICES

2. UNIVERSIDAD DE ZARAGOZA

2.1. School of Engineering and Architecture

Programme: Degree in Computer Engineering

The ATENEO of the School of Engineering and Architecture of the University of Zaragoza (EINA) is a cultural activity that began in March 1996. It is an open forum for the presentation and discussion of ideas on science and technology, scientific thought, human and social sciences, etc.

Sessions are usually held every two weeks within the school term. The session opens with the presentation of the guest speaker. The guest speaker then develops the topic of the session followed by a discussion. The maximum duration of a session at the Athenaeum is two hours.

The speakers invited to the Ateneo are leading figures from the university, cultural, business or institutional world and leading specialists in the subject matter of the session.

Programme: Degree in Chemical Engineering

✓ The ATENEO initiative of the EINA as a means of linking the University with society and the world of work.

The ATENEO of the School of Engineering and Architecture of the University of Zaragoza (EINA) is a cultural activity that began in March 1996. It is an open forum for the presentation and discussion of ideas on science and technology, scientific thought, human and social sciences, etc.

Programme: Degree in Industrial Design and Product Development Engineering

✓ System of headings for competence assessment (http://redu.net/redu/index.php/REDU/article/view/776)

The main objective of the experience has been the planning, coordination and implementation of an assessment system based on the use of rubrics for the final qualification of module work, an interdisciplinary and collaborative teaching model implemented since the 2008-2009 academic year, which responds to the modular organization of the Degree, and in which the contents and competences of the first semester are worked on in a coordinated manner. The project arises from the need to create an assessment system for module work that integrates both the assessment of specific and

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transversal skills. In this way, a total of eight headings have been designed, four for transversal competences and four for specific ones, together with a survey to evaluate the experience. The project has meant an improvement in the evaluation practice of the work by modules, going deeper into it and the importance of each competence, establishing common evaluation criteria among the teaching team, detecting learning needs and providing the student with a tool for planning.

- ✓ Innovative activities such as the annual exhibition "Emerging Projects", which shows a selection of projects by students of the EINA Degree in Industrial Design Engineering and Product Development, as well as the cycle of conferences and workshops "Design Week at the EINA", with seven editions to date focused on the relationship of design with other elements such as Employment, Culture, New Product Opportunities or Science.
- ✓ The ATENEO initiative of the EINA as a means of linking the University with society and the world of work.

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Programme: Degree in Telecommunications Technologies and Services Engineering

- ✓ The existence of a common virtual space, developed with the BSCW tool, through which all teachers exchange information related to the degree, which facilitates horizontal and vertical coordination processes.

- ✓ In events such as the graduation of students at the EUPT, there are representatives from the Chamber of Commerce of Teruel, the Association of Industrial Engineers of Aragon, the Spanish Confederation of Business Organisations (CEOE) Teruel, the Department of Information and Communication Technology Services of the Provincial Council of Teruel and the City Council of Teruel. This shows an interest in linking the degree (along with others from the EUPT) with the city/community environment.

2.2. Higher Polytechnic School

Programme: Degree in Agrifood and Rural Engineering

✓ The "Open Knowledge, Meeting Space" programme offers one day a week of complementary activities such as talks, conferences, meetings, etc.

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2.3. University Defence Centre (CUD)

Programme: Degree in Industrial Organization Engineering

✓ Conferences on quality

The University Defence Centre of Zaragoza and the University Quality and Prospective Agency of Aragon organised these study days on the 7th and 8th of November 2012, with the aim of presenting and debating the tasks and experiences in the different areas related to quality assessment in teaching and research, both by the University Quality Agencies involved and by the different University Defence Centres.

✓ Research projects

Since 2013, the CUD has had specific calls for funding of research projects. Its aim is to exploit the centre's research potential in lines of work of interest in the field of the Armed Forces and peace, security and defence, as well as to encourage the research activity of the centre's teaching staff as an obligation inherent in their status as university lecturers, promoting the formation of new research groups among its members.

The calls are intended to encourage quality research, evidenced both by the internationalization of activities and the publication of their results in forums with a high scientific and technological impact, and by their contribution to the solution of social, economic and technological problems that may be of interest to the Armed Forces and to peace, security and defense.

The evaluation of the applications is carried out by an external committee of scientific experts appointed by the ACPA.

2.4. La Almunia de Dª Godina Polytechnic University School (EUPLA)

Carried out by a multidisciplinary team from the University of Zaragoza made up of sixteen students of Architecture from the EINA and nine students of Technical Architecture and Civil Engineering from the EUPLA, coordinated by seven teachers. This project has received an "honourable mention" for its interactivity in the International Universities Powering Transformation competition with its proposal "Not Only Football", called within the framework of the prestigious international congress WSB14 world sustainable building.
