 Pilot project for the assessment of learning outcomes carried out in collaboration with the ACPUA.

This project was based on the difficulty in measuring the learning outcomes of the programmes due to the lack of definition of the same, being an initial task the necessary concreteness and coherence between exit profiles, objectives and competences of the programme. The Environmental Sciences programme course participated voluntarily in this project, generating through it a proposal to improve the programme course that was taken into account for the elaboration of the proposal to modify the programme course.

- "Matrix of programme".

This is a systematic procedure for contextualising and coordinating the specific competences in the bachelor's degree courses that requires the participation of the programme teaching team, which, with the help of an online computer application developed ex-profeso by the programme, analyses the relationships between the subjects in a bachelor's degree course. The output product, called the Matrix of programme, provides a map of links that allows the detection of key subjects, isolated subjects, links between non-reciprocal subjects, inadequate sequencing, gaps and unnecessary duplication. All this information should be used for the proper planning of the teaching of the subjects that will be reflected in the corresponding guides. It also has the function of promoting the collaborative work of the





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teaching team of the programme and provides useful information both for possible changes to the curriculum and for the new teachers who join each course. And, ultimately, it contributes to the continuous improvement of the quality of the programme.

- Public information management.

Both the levels of transparency of the public information and the self-reporting model for the accreditation, as well as the display of information contained in the different Quality Evaluation Reports and the Learning Outcomes of the programme, constitute a good practice that can serve as a model for other programmes of the Universidad de Zaragoza.

Good practices detected:

- Development of a computer application that allows for the continuous updating of the teaching activities agenda in order to inform students and teachers in a timely manner. This agenda includes each and every one of the teaching-learning activities called for in each subject (master classes, seminars, laboratory or pilot plant practices, visits to companies or research centres, continuous assessment tests, deadlines for submissions, etc.). The application provides a clear vision of the teaching-learning activities planned for both students and teachers. In the case of students, it is also customisable, so that they can include in their diaries the activities of the different subjects in which they are enrolled.

- Integration of subjects from different disciplinary modules around projects focused on the development of the specific competences of the professional profiles of the Bachelor's Degree. Specifically, 3 integration projects have been designed (involving 8 subjects) focused on the professional profiles of "Management and quality control of products in the food sector", "Food processing", "Food safety" and "Development and innovation of processes and products in the food sector".

- Creation of specific teaching material (more than 50 documents located in a repository) with QR codes located in each of the pilot plant's equipment. By means of the mobile devices, either their own or those available in the plant, and the creation of an internal network, students can continue to train autonomously, consulting the videos on how to use the equipment and the practice protocols, which is of great help in passing the last subjects of the programme ("Practicum Planta Piloto" and "Trabajo Fin de Grado").

- Implementation of Quality Assurance Systems

In December 2011 Universidad San Jorge obtained, from the certifying entity AENOR, the ISO-9001:2008 (Registration Number ER-1191/2011) and ISO-14001:2004 (Registration Number GA-2011/0619) certifications for its Integrated Quality and Environmental Management System.

In November 2013 Universidad San Jorge received, from the Certification Commission constituted by ANECA, two favourable reports without conditions on the implementation of its Internal Quality Assurance System in accordance with the requirements of the AUDIT programme in the Centres submitted for evaluation: Faculty of Health Sciences and Faculty of Communication.

Although this certification did not reach the School of Government and Leadership to which this Master's degree is attached, the implementation of the IQAS of Universidad San Jorge is common to all its programmes, reaching levels of excellence. On the other hand, the culture of quality and continual improvement is established in all the groups of the University.

- Personalised attention to students:

The student orientation tutorials, to select the itinerary (research or professional) and the personalised follow-up of the students' performance, are aspects that are highly valued by the students.

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- Personalised attention to students:

A good practice is the Tutorial Action Plan which assigns a tutor to each student from the moment they enter university with the aim of accompanying them throughout the learning process. A mentoring programme has been set up, through which students from higher education courses welcome and inform new students starting their programme.

The coordination is also noteworthy, through the figures of the vice-dean and programme coordinator as well as the external and internal internship coordinators and the annual coordination meetings within the different blocks of subjects.
