

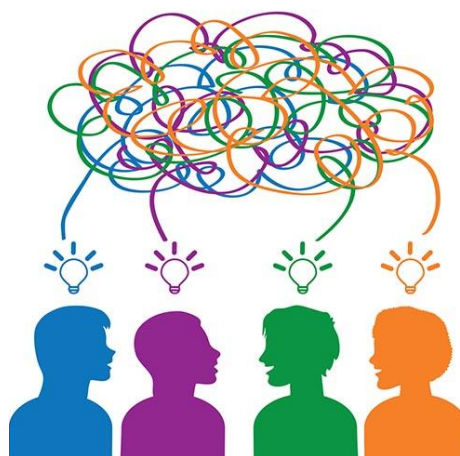
FOCUS GROUP

Dialogues with ACPUA

ACPUA, having now been listed in the European EQAR register and having achieved all the competences in the field of degree evaluation, covering the entire life cycle of all official degrees in an Aragonese university, now requires a general framework for the evaluation of degrees. In this context, it is now necessary to undertake a significant process of reflecting upon and reviewing evaluation procedures. The first step of this is to collect feedback from all parties involved in quality assurance.

You are therefore invited to a Date with QA in Aragon: ACPUA is initiating a "bottom-up" dialogue in which the focus will not only be the university degrees but also the people who work on the "frontline" (vice chancellors, coordinators, members of quality assurance commissions, students, etc.).

The aim of this focus group session will be to analyse and gather your feedback (by means of the focus group methodology) on how the quality assurance cycle of university education in Aragon can be evolved and improved, thereby making its processes more efficient and effective. Our idea is to bring together around 20-30 individuals with whom we can work in small groups, using practical dynamics, to explore the following areas:



- A. Degree verification/modification. How improvements in efficiency and effectiveness in these processes could improve the quality of the degrees.
- B. Degree follow-up How improvements in efficiency and effectiveness in these processes could improve the quality of the degrees.
- C. Degree accreditation: How improvements in efficiency and effectiveness in these processes could improve the quality of the degrees.
- D. Student-centred learning

This session will be the first step in the aforementioned process of reflecting upon and reviewing procedures. All information compiled will be submitted to the various ACPUA committees to be analysed and subsequently undergo meta-evaluation.

This process will be carried out in the months of June/July in Zaragoza, Huesca and Teruel.
