Subject: Reconfirmation of ACPUA membership in ENQA

Dear Prof. Dr. Rodríguez Coarasa,

I am pleased to inform you that, at its meeting of 9 September 2026, the ENQA Board agreed to reconfirm ACPUA's membership in ENQA for five years from that date. The Board concluded that ACPUA is fulfilling the membership criteria according to Article 5, paragraph 1 of ENQA's Rules of Procedure, being compliant "with Parts 2 and 3 of the *Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG 2015)*", in line with the EQAR's Approval of the Application for Renewal of Inclusion on the Register (Ref. RC50/A172). The decision will be submitted to the General Assembly for endorsement at its next meeting.

The Board would like to encourage ACPUA to attend an online follow-up seminar, where all agencies that have participated in a targeted review will discuss the self-selected topics of enhancement. The seminar aims to provide an arena for strategic conversations that will allow agencies to reflect on their key challenges, opportunities, and priorities. The ENQA Secretariat will be in touch with you in about a two years' time to discuss this event. To prepare for the follow-up seminar, the agency will be asked to demonstrate changes or developments within the agency following the targeted review (e.g., in the form of a poster). More information on the follow-up to targeted reviews can be found in the Guidelines for ENQA Agency Reviews (Annex II).
